SUBJECT: USING YOUR BADGE TO BYPASS SCREENING TO BOARD A FLIGHT IS A SECURITY VIOLATION



If traveling for business or pleasure, you MUST go through a screening checkpoint before boarding your flight.

If you bypass security for the purpose of boarding a flight, you WILL BE criminally charged and your MSP security badge WILL BE REVOKED for two (2) years.

MAC Ordinance 91 Sub. 6.1 Bypassing Security Screening Area

No Person shall bypass security screening. All Persons entering a security area for the purpose of travel or boarding an aircraft must first pass through a security screening area that has been installed with equipment for inspection of Person(s) and their belongings.

Security at MSP is YOUR responsibility!
