**SUBJECT:** **MSP CHALLENGE PROCEDURE**

### “CHALLENGE”

A process by which individuals having authorized access to the Secured Area SIDA or the AOA SIDA contact, approach or point out individuals or vehicles present in those areas who are not displaying appropriate security badges.

### CHALLENGE PROCEDURE

In a non-threatening manner, challenge anyone who is not displaying a proper security area badge.

Approach the person and request to see their badge or valid escort. Be sure to look at the picture of the person and the expiration date.



- 1) If the person that you challenge produces and shows their badge, remind them to keep it properly displayed at all times.**
- 2) If the person FAILS to produce a valid badge or a valid escort, immediately CALL 911 to notify the Airport Police. When possible, keep the person in sight until the police arrive.**
